## **IMPROVING SAFETY AND SECURITY**

We have some exciting updates on the ongoing efforts to enhance safety and security in our neighborhood. Here's what you need to know:

**Upgraded Radio Network:** The Wi-Fi interference experienced along the South Boundary has been addressed through an upgrade, ensuring a more reliable connection for our community.

**Better Camera Coverage:** We're taking steps to improve our surveillance system. New radios will soon be swapped out, aimed at enhancing our radio receivers across the valley. This will result in a more stable link to the CCP control room, Omni Vision, and improved feeds for our CCTV system.

**License Plate Recognition Camera:** As an additional layer of oversight, we have provisioned a CCTC camera with License Plate Recognition (LPR) capabilities. This camera, located near the trench towards the school, will help monitor flagged cars entering the area.

**Expanded Camera Network:** To further enhance our monitoring capabilities, we are adding a second Network Video Recorder (NVR) to increase the capacity of our camera network.

**Community Involvement:** We greatly appreciate the feeds provided by a resident along Hughenden, which have been incorporated into our off-site monitoring service. This collaboration strengthens our ability to track and locate wanted individuals with the help of SSPs.



**Clearing Vegetation:** We're working on clearing vegetation that obstructs the line of sight for our CCTV cameras, ensuring optimal surveillance coverage across our community.

**Enhanced Intersection Security:** A CCTV camera, along with a light, will be installed at the Corner of Hughenden & Main Road. This will improve visibility and help identify any unwanted individuals loitering around the intersection.



**Rise in Break-Ins:** Unfortunately, there has been a recent increase in break-ins within our neighborhood, including one along Hughenden, a mugging incident, and a snatch-and-grab at the Main Road intersection. We urge all residents to remain vigilant, secure their boundaries, and keep doors and windows locked.

**Safer on the neighbourhood roads:** We have installed traffic mirrors to help in areas where viewing oncoming traffic is hard to see. Please drive respectfully on our roads.
